Other News

Enrollment Report and Outlook

The District's total enrollment for May 2011 (not including Skills Center or Running Start) is 3,576.09 FTE (Full Time Equivalent). This is 123.36 FTE fewer than last year at this time and 12.15 FTE students below budget. The budget is based upon the average FTE over the entire school year. Awards & Gifts Accepted –

Port Angeles High School teamed up with Price Ford Lincoln of Port Angeles for the second time this year in the Drive One 4 UR School program - \$5,380 was donated to PAHS ASB and Band programs.

High School Science Progress Report

The science assessment graduation requirement has been delayed until the class of 2015 (current 8th graders). Beginning with the class of 2015, students will have to pass the reading and writing HSPE, two end-of-course exams in algebra 1 and geometry, and an end-of-course exam in biology.

Collaborative Time Task Force Recommendation

The Board voted for the implementation of collaborative time as it exists currently for all District teachers and principals for the 2011-12 school year. We plan to consider a plan for common collaborative time for all schools throughout the District beginning with the 2012-13 school year. This will be studied in conjunction with the work by the Elementary School Restructuring Task Force.

The CEE survey, a survey in which we ask staff, students and parents questions about the characteristics of High Performing Schools and Port Angeles School District schools, will be conducted in November 2011.
