Guidance now has applications for the **Port Angeles Football Club Reath Ellefson Scholarship**. Only students who did not submit a scholarship notebook may apply. **Due April 20th.**

The Sequim Arts Scholarship Fund offers a \$500 to \$1000 to a student pursuing a career in art, fine arts, art education, or commercial art. Students should have a 2.5 minimum gpa and be able to provide the committee with a portfolio of their work. **Applications are due April 1st.**

Watts Constructors is offering a \$2500 scholarship for students planning to study Construction Management at a college or university. Students need to have a 3.0 and be involved in school and community. **Due March 15th.**
