The Spring Passion Project Fair will be June 1st from 9:30-11:30!

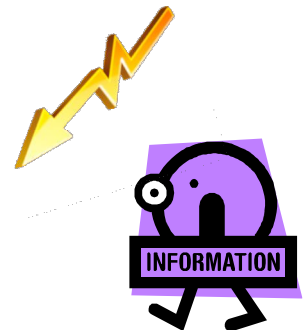
Students may choose any topic they are passionate about and would like to learn more. Students should research the topic and prepare an oral presentation.
