June 17th the Statue of Liberty was brought to New York. Your child can learn more about the Statue of

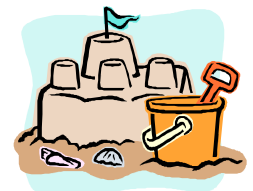
