

# **NORTH OLYMPIC BASEBALL and SOFTBALL 2012**

## **YOUTH BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL REGISTRATION IS COMING!**

**WHEN?** February 1 and 2 from 7 PM to 8:30 PM. **WHERE?** Vern Burton Community Center

**FOR WHOM?** All girls aged 5 to 16 (with birthdays between December 31, 1995, and December 31, 2006)

All boys aged 5 to 12 (with birthdays between May 1, 1999, and April 30, 2007)

In 2012 we hope to offer seven programs in North Olympic Youth Baseball and Softball:

1. **TEE BALL** for youngsters aged 5 to 7 in a low pressure, skill building program. Practice and play will take place from March 30 through June 16.
2. **A LEAGUE BASEBALL** designed for boys 8 and above who have mastered tee ball, but who are not yet ready for live pitching. Practice and play take part between March 30 and June 16.
3. **12U MINOR SOFTBALL** designed for girls 8 through 11 with developing skills. Practice and play March 30 to June 16
4. **AA and AAA LEAGUE BASEBALL** designed for boys 9 through 12 with developing skills. Practice and play from March 23 through June 16.
5. **12U MAJOR SOFTBALL** designed for girls 9 through 12 with established skills. Practice and play between March 21 and June 16.
6. **MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL** designed for boys aged 9 through 12 with established skills. Practice and play between March 14 and June 16.
7. **16U SOFTBALL** for girls aged 13 through 16. Practice and play between March 21 and June 16.

**REGISTRATION** takes place early, so we can accommodate everyone. The program fee is \$20 per player, with a family maximum of \$50. (A waiver of fees or deferred payment are available where needed.) In keeping with program regulations, youngsters are required to have acceptable birth certificates, and all youngsters must gain medical clearance before taking part in competition. (Registration by mail will be allowed prior to February 15, for those who completed the 2010 season, and who have been provided registration forms by mail.)

**KIDS:** Be sure your families get you registered by mail before February 15, or in person February 2 or 3. And remember that your Moms and Dads are welcome to take part too.

**PARENTS:** The local program served about 600 youngsters on 44 teams in 2011. We've always been able to make room for everyone, and we commit ourselves to serve all timely registrants. With a program this large, though, there is need for a great deal of planning, and there are physical limits, so everyone, including returning players, must register on time to be guaranteed a spot.
